

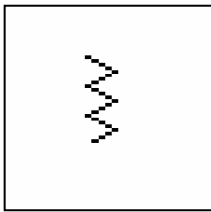
## Beading

Beading Feet are sold in sets of two, each having a different size of groove. Select the appropriate foot for the size of your beads.

Wide groove foot (L)..... For beads or pearls 2.5 - 4.0 mm in diameter

Narrow groove foot (S) ..... For beads or pearls up to 2 mm in diameter

Machine Settings:



Foot: Beading Foot (optional foot)

Foot Pressure: 3.0

Stitch Width: 2.0 - 3.0

Stitch Length: 1.5

Thread Tension: 3.0 - 5.0

Needle Thread: Clear Monofilament Thread

Bobbin Thread: All-Purpose Thread

Tips:

- \* Choose beads that are strung on nylon thread. Those strung on cotton tend to break more easily.
- \* Beads strung on nylon thread tend to shift and form gaps during application. Affix tape to each end of the string before sewing to prevent the beads from shifting.

1. Draw an outline on the fabric where the string(s) of beads or pearls will be attached.
2. Place the fabric under the foot.
3. Arrange the string of beads or pearls on the fabric, and then lower the foot so that the beads fit in the groove on the bottom of the foot.
